NY-25: One debate set, more possible

U.S. Rep. Louise Slaughter, D-Fairport, and Monroe County Executive Maggie Brooks, R-Webster, have already agreed to debate.

Now, the next question: How many times?

Both candidates have agreed to a debate sponsored by the League of Women Voters, to air on Channel 8 Oct. 30. However, Brooks wants more. Her campaign said she has committed to six, and is calling on the Slaughter campaign to commit to them too.

Eric Walker, spokesman for Slaughter, said the campaign expects to commit to more than one, but could not give a time frame on when they'd make the commitments.
