The Fair Election Practices Campaign begins on Aug. 13, [the League of Women Voters/Rochester Metro Area](#) (LWV/RMA) and The Interfaith Alliance of Rochester (TIAR) announced.

The campaign, established in the 1970s, promotes issue-oriented and civil campaigning among candidates for public office. All candidates have been requested to sign a pledge promising to follow those principles. The Fair Election Practices Committee (FEPC) was established to hear complaints from those who feel their opponent has violated the pledge.
